

PRIMARY ELECTION FACT SHEET

- Election Date: Tuesday, June 8, 2010
- Poll Hours: 7:00 am to 9:00 pm
- Voter Registration Deadlines: Mail voter registration forms worry-free postmarked date is May 24th. Registration postmarked on or before this day are considered on time to pre-register, even if they are received after 5 p.m. on May 29th. Voter registrations delivered to the County Auditor's office or done in person must be completed on or before five o'clock pm on Saturday, May 29th to be pre-register.
- Where to Register: The Guthrie County Auditor's Office, 200 N. 5th Street, Guthrie Center, weekdays between the hours of 8:00 am and 4:30 pm.
- Registration Changes: Name and address changes within Guthrie County may be made any time up to and including election day. Prior to election day, changes are made by the same means as registration. On election day changes may be made at the voters **new** polling place. Changes of address from outside Guthrie County are considered new registrations.
- Absentee Voting: Absentee votes may be cast at the Election Office through June 7th, the day prior to the election. Request forms for absentee ballots may be obtained at the Guthrie County Auditor's Office, on the Guthrie County website at www.guthriecounty.org/elections, or the State of Iowa website at www.sos.state.ia.us. Official Absentee Request forms must be used, the Auditor's Office can not send out an absentee ballot requested on any thing other then the official form. The last day for the Auditor's office to mail an absentee ballot is Friday, June 4th.
- Voted absentee ballots must be postmarked by midnight the day prior to the election (June 7th) or may be dropped off at the Auditor's Office before the polls close (9:00 pm) on election day, June 8th.

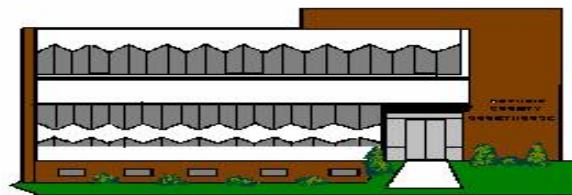

For Release after April 29, 2010:

Jerri Christman, Guthrie County Auditor, announces that absentee ballots for the Primary Election to be held June 8th are now available in the Auditor's office.

Any person unable to get to the polls on June 8, 2010, may fill out and send an Official Absentee Request form to the Guthrie County Auditor's Office, 200 N. 5th Street, Guthrie Center, IA 50115. The request must contain the name, address, address where the ballot is to be mailed, and the request must be signed by the person requesting a ballot. Requests must be received by 5:00 p.m. on Friday, June 4th. You may obtain the official Absentee Request form from Guthrie County's Website at: www.guthriecounty.org/elections.

Absentee ballots may also be voted in the Auditor's office week days from 8:00 a.m. until 4:30 p.m. and Saturday, May 29th from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. and Saturday, June 5th, from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

Anyone having questions regarding absentee voting may contact the Auditor's office, 641-747-3619.

For Release prior to May 29, 2010:

The Guthrie County Auditor's Office will be open on Saturday, May 29th, from 8:00 a.m. until 5:00 p.m. for the purpose of registering voters for the June 8th, Primary Election. This is the last day to pre-registration to vote on June 8, 2010. Iowa law now permits Election Day Registration.

For Release prior to June 5, 2010:

The Guthrie County Auditor's Office will be open Saturday, June 5th, from 9:00 a.m. until 5:00 p.m. for the purpose of voting an absentee ballot for the June 8th, Primary Election.

Absentee ballots for the June 8th, Primary Election may be cast at the Auditor's Office, Guthrie County Courthouse, 200 N. 5th Street, Guthrie Center, through June 4th or by mail. Absentee ballots mailed must be postmarked by June 7th at midnight.
